## Celebrations

- Increased volunteering teaching staff (5 new volunteers) and parents/carers (5 new volunteers). Pupils volunteering as coaches, referees and table officials. Saves money, develops people, aligns with national (sportscotland) and local (CEC) values and priorities.
- Female empowerment two female teachers voluntarily leading a Latin Dance club and Girls' Strength Club respectively, along with an all-female line up of Leadership Academy / Young Ambassador pupils. Planning a female physical activity and sport awareness week this year.
- Sporting success S1 boys & girls basketball teams qualified for Scottish Cup National Finals in March, S2-3 and S4-6 teams in regional final 4 (chance of qualifying for national finals).

  - Targeted swimming project partnership with SfL/PEF staff in Learning Community

## Challenges
